Others sites include Sri Ram Tirath, Rambagh gardens, Gobindgarh fort, wetland and Gurudwara Nanaksar, Harike.

Amritsaris are born hosts, and are famous for having a palate for eating. The city is famous for its culinary delicacies like multi-layered prathas, tandoori kulchas, puris, fried fish, seekh kabab, barbecued chicken and spicy pickles.



At just distance of 200 kms is Dharamshala which is full of scenic as well as cultural delights. The 3-hour trek to Triund is the best thing to do in Dharamshala as it provides some spectacular views even before one reaches the top.
